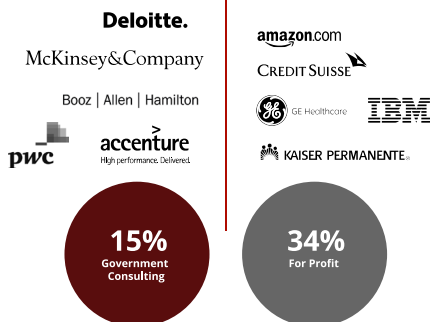

Graduates of Heinz College's MSPPM program are employed in a variety of decision-making roles in government agencies, public and non-profit institutions, and private research and consulting firms.



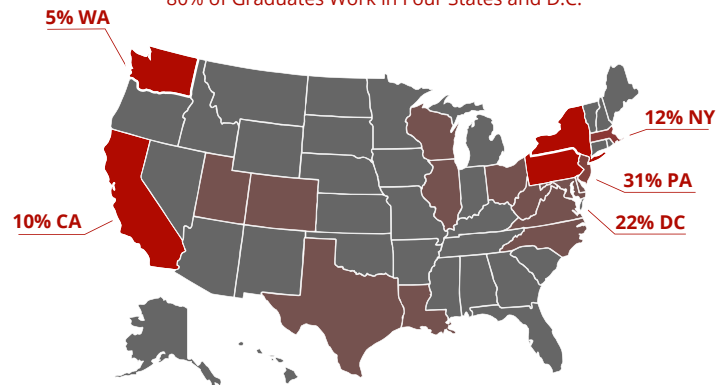
