2 Install & Register Exemplify for iPad

1. On your iPad device, open the App Store
2. Search for Exemplify for iPad or ExamSoft to find the application
3. Tap the button to install the app

Install & Register Exemplify

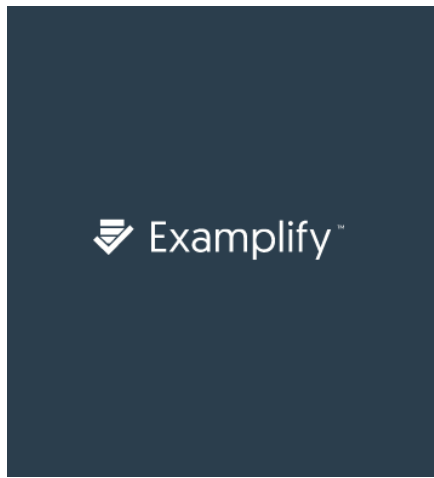
1. Click "Download"
2. Click "Save File"
3. Navigate to your "Downloads" folder and double-click "Exemplify.dmg"
4. In the "Exemplify" device folder, click on "Install Exemplify.mpkg"
5. Follow the steps of the Exemplify Installer.

5. Follow the on-screen instructions to download the installer file.
6. After the download is finished, go to the **Downloads** folder on your device, and run the installer file.

Note: If your device is a Mac with the M1 processor, you'll be prompted to install Rosetta. You must select **Install** to continue the Exemplify installation. For more information, see: [Exemplify: Tips for Installation on a Mac with an M1 Chip](#)

7. After the installation is finished, start Exemplify.
8. On the **Add New Account** page, enter your **institution ID – pittlaw**, and then select **Next**.

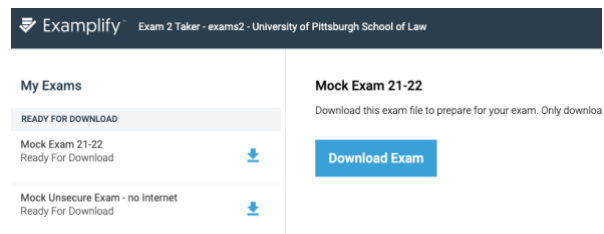
9. You will be redirected to Pitt Passport for your **login credentials**.

Practice an Exam to Confirm Device Compliance

Exams that are ready for you will be displayed once the software is logged on. If you do not see your exams, ensure they are on the [In-Class Exam Schedule](#). If they are on the in-class schedule and you still don't see them, please check back 24 hours prior to your exam start.

You will see at least two exams (see below). You will see that you have two mock exams to ensure you are ready for exam day.

- Mock Exam 21-22 is a secure exam intended to practice what an in-class exam will be like.
- Mock Unsecure Exam – no Internet is intended to practice an in-class exam that allows an eBook that must be able to be read offline.



Taking a Mock Exam

1. Select whichever exam you will be practicing with, click the download symbol to download it.

2. Once an exam is downloaded, you can see all the features that it has turned on or off to set your expectation on how the exam will run. Pay attention especially to:

- Secure means that it will not allow you to access anything on your computer while you are taking the exam.
- WiFi On or Off shows whether or not you will have access to the Internet during the exam.

3. To take the exam, you must put in an Exam ID and an Exam Password.
